On or about June 30, 2020, Village of La Grange Park intends to apply to the Illinois Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity for a grant from the Rebuild Illinois program. This program is funded by state funds as included in the 2019 Capital Bill. These funds are to be used to construct a central area storm sewer separation program. The intended scope is to install a new storm water conveyance system to reduce storm water from entering the combination sewer system to reduce backups in homes and reduce roadway flooding. The new system is intended to convey storm water to the Salt Creek waterway. The total amount of Rebuild Illinois funds to be requested is \$4,800,000. The Village of La Grange Park also proposes to expend \$93,000 from the Village's Sewer Fund for this project.

Information and a draft application related to this project will be available for review before the Public Hearing on the Village's website at www.lagrangepark.org on June 22, 2020. RE: Rebuild Illinois - Resolution for Local Funding Central Area Storm Sewer Separation

PURPOSE:

To seek approval of a Resolution to commit local funding earmarked for storm water projects to pursue a Rebuild Illinois Public Infrastructure Grant.

GENERAL BACKGROUND:

Recently, the State of Illinois introduced a grant opportunity administered through the DCEO to assist in rebuilding the local economy, the Rebuild Illinois Public Infrastructure Grant Program.

After much consideration, staff recommends submitting a grant application requesting \$4,896,506 to assist with the costs of a Storm Water Separation Program for the Central Area. After the May 17, 2020 storm event, significant flooding to our community occurred and particularly in the Central Area. This area has been under consideration for some time now, to install a system to bring relief to basement backups, and significant street and overland flooding.

As part of the grant submission to the Rebuild Illinois program, a Public Hearing is required for the use of public funds. Earlier this evening, the Public Hearing was conducted. Public Funds will only be utilized if the Village is awarded this grant. These funds are from the Sewer Fund and are specifically earmarked for storm water projects.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends the approval of the Resolution for Local Funding in the Amount of \$93,000 at the Special Village Work Board meeting on June 29, 2020.

RESOLUTION COMMITTING LOCAL FUNDS

Rebuild Illinois - Application Process



- Competitive Public Infrastructure Grant
 - Grant amounts - \$250,000 up to \$5,000,000
 - Construction within 24 months, with a one time extension of up to 12 months
 - Submission Deadline: June 30, 2020 at 5:00 pm (Original Application)
- Letters of Support
 - Residents from the affected area
 - Community Organizations
 - Local Legislators
- Dollar Amount Seeking - \$4,896,506
- Village Match - \$93,000

Rebuild Illinois – Project Overview



- Storm Sewer Separation programs are intended to convey storm water in its own pipe network to a local waterway, in our case the Salt Creek River system. Fully functional systems such as these provide multiple benefits including:
 - Reduces storm water in the Village’s combination system, providing relief from basement backups.
 - Reduces street flooding which is a cause of concern for response of emergency operation vehicles.
 - Reduces overland flooding, which is increasingly getting worse.
 - Reducing street flooding will have less of a chance of damaging structures (i.e. homes, basements)
 - Reduces vehicle damage occurring due to flash flooding of streets and driveways.

- PHASE I**

CONSTRUCT A 18"x30" ELLIPTICAL STORM SEWER ON FOREST ROAD FROM 30TH STREET TO 31ST STREET.

- PHASE II**

CONSTRUCT A 8'x 7' BOX CULVERT ON JACKSON AVENUE FROM BARNSDALE ROAD TO HOMESTEAD ROAD, THE INSTALLATION OF A 8,000 GPM PUMP STATION AT PUBLIC WORKS SITE (NORTHEAST CORNER OF JACKSON AVENUE AND BARNSDALE ROAD) AND THE INSTALLATION OF A 16" FORCE MAIN ON BARNSDALE ROAD, GARFIELD AVENUE AND FOREST ROAD TO 31ST STREET.

CONSTRUCT A 48" STORM SEWER ON HOMESTEAD ROAD FROM MONROE AVENUE TO OAK AVENUE.

CONSTRUCT A 24" STORM SEWER ON HARDING AVENUE AND OAK AVENUE FROM BARNSDALE ROAD TO FOREST ROAD.
