

Village of La Grange Park  
Youth Commission- Meeting Minutes  
June 10, 2019

A meeting of the La Grange Park Youth Commission was called to order at 7:00 p.m. on Monday, June 10, 2019 at the La Grange Park Village Hall.

**1. Call to Order**

Assistant Village Manager Emily Rodman called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

There was no public comment.

**5. Approval of Minutes- May 13, 2019**

*There was a motion to approve the minutes of May 13, 2019 by Will Aikens. The motion was seconded by Evie Anagnos and passed unanimously by voice vote.*

**6. Village Board Meeting Sign Up**

Assistant Manager Rodman discussed the importance of attending a Village Board Work Session Meeting.

**7. Approval of 2019-2020 Meeting Schedule**

*Jack Tullis made a motion to approve the 2019-2020 Meeting schedule as presented. Timothy Sands seconded the motion. The motion passed on a voice vote.*

**8. Review of Village Board Work Session Meeting of June 11, 2019**

Evie Anagnos volunteered to chair the meeting. Ms. Anagnos read the Village Board Agenda Memo regarding the keeping of backyard chickens. The Commissioners discussed the request at length,

touching on the following topics: concerns about pests and disease, the likelihood of residents giving up the chickens, experience of other communities, the proximity of homes to the Forest Preserve, lot sizes, notice requirements to adjacent neighbors, etc. At the conclusion of the discussion, the group could not reach a consensus and was split 3-3 on whether to overturn the prohibition on backyard chickens.

Chairwoman Evie Anagnos summarized the Village Board Agenda Memo regarding Zoning Application No. 2019-01, 340 N. Spring. At the end of discussion there was a *Consensus to Approve an Ordinance Granting Certain Variations for 340 N. Spring (Public Hearing 2019-01)*.

Chairwoman Evie Anagnos summarized the Village Board Agenda Memo regarding the 2019 Alley and Beach Off Street Parking Engineering Agreements. Assistant Manager Rodman explained why the Village was seeking to install the additional off-street parking on Beach Avenue. The Commissioners asked Assistant Manager Rodman to explain how the Tax Increment Financing District worked. Following the discussion, there was a *Consensus to Approve the Motion: To Approve and Authorize the Village Manager to Execute Agreements Between the Village of La Grange Park and Edwin Hancock Engineering for Engineering Services in an Amount Not to Exceed, as Follows: (1) \$33,400 for Design and Construction Engineering – 2019 Alley Reconstruction Project (2) \$5,300 for Design and Construction Engineering – 2019 Beach Off Street Parking Project*.

Chairwoman Evie Anagnos read the Village Board Agenda Memo regarding the Appointment to the Sustainability Commission. At the end of discussion there was *Consensus to approve the Motion: To Appoint Bill Withrow to the Sustainability Commission to Serve a Three Year Term Expiring in May, 2022*.

#### **9. Adjourn-next meeting September 9, 2019**

With no further business to come before the Commission, *there was a motion to adjourn. The motion to adjourn was made by Evie Anagnos and was seconded by Timothy Sands and passed unanimously by voice vote.*

The meeting was adjourned at 8:00 pm.
