Re: Fire Department Activities – SEPTEMBER 2016

As requested for insertion into the Village Board meeting agenda packet, the following is a brief summary of Fire Department activity highlights for the month of September. As usual, a more comprehensive monthly report is kept within the department for your review.

EMS Responses for this month - 130. There have been 1262 YTD compared to 1297 YTD in 2015.  
Fire/Rescue Incidents this month - 36. There have been 350 YTD compared to 385 YTD in 2015.

Firefighters underwent annual medical evaluations during the month, which took place on-site in a mobile medical RV.

On the 28<sup>th</sup>, an applicant Orientation session was held for POC Firefighters. Those interested in continuing through the applicant testing process will need to successfully complete an oral interview, physical ability test, background investigation, and medical evaluation in the coming months.

On the 18<sup>th</sup> of the month, some of our personnel participated in the annual softball tournament to honor Mark Johnson, who died on duty as the Deputy Fire Chief in Hinsdale, and who also was a firefighter here for several years. Our team made it to the Championship game, but lost to the Hinsdale Public Services (Works) Department in extra innings.

During the month, we began providing our annual fire safety programs to our schools, in relation to the upcoming Fire Prevention Week. Personnel also participated in a number of other public education and special events, including various remembrance services for the 15<sup>th</sup> Anniversary for the 9/11 attacks (Patriot's Day). Also, the official Opening and Ribbon Cutting of the new Emergency Department at Adventist La Grange Memorial Hospital took place this past month.

Personnel attended and participated in the Memorial Service, and Fire Department Bell Service, for Retired Fire Department Captain Bill Becker who passed away.

Sep 3<sup>rd</sup> Sat at 9:35 pm: Responded to a fire at the Village's "leaf/brush dump". There were no injuries or property damage, but fire was fairly significant, and firefighters remained on the scene for several hours, along with a Public Works employee, completely extinguishing the fire.

Sep 19<sup>th</sup> Mon at 1:48 pm: Responded with an Engine to a MABAS 3-11 alarm fire in Cicero.

Sep 24<sup>th</sup> Sat at 3:29 am: Responded with an Engine to a MABAS 2-11 alarm fire in Burr Ridge.

Sep 26<sup>th</sup> Mon at 2:38 pm: Responded to a natural gas leak on a gas line at 819 Sherwood. Personnel were able to secure the leak by shutting down the meter.



## EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES ACTIVITY REPORT – SEPTEMBER 2016

### Ambulance Responses:

This month, EMT and Paramedic personnel responded to a total of 130 requests for emergency medical services treating a total of 132 patients. There were 96 calls located west of the IHB Railroad and 26 calls east of the IHB Railroad. Year to date, there has been a total of 1262 requests for service treated 1275 patients.

This compares to last year (September 2015) when there were 132 requests for service with a year to date total of 1297 responses.

### Training and Continuing Education:

EMT continuing education was held on Tuesday, September 13<sup>th</sup> in the Community Room at Fire Station #1. Paramedic continuing education was conducted on Monday, September 19<sup>th</sup>, Wednesday, September 21<sup>st</sup>, and Friday, September 23<sup>rd</sup> at the LaGrange Fire Department.

### Special Activities:

Members continued viewing and looking at ambulances and ambulance manufacturers working toward a recommendation to the Village for the purchase of a replacement ambulance in early fall.

On September 2<sup>nd</sup> – Firefighters Wittman and Palicka provided ambulance and paramedic coverage at the Nazareth High School Football game.

On September 16<sup>th</sup> – Firefighters Wittman and Chorley provided ambulance and paramedic coverage at the Nazareth High School Football game.

In September, Firefighter/Paramedics Bink, Gajeski, and Wittman conduct CPR and AED certification training for the teachers in School District 95.






