

Village of La Grange Park  
Sustainability Commission – Minutes  
Monday February 10, 2014

The meeting of the La Grange Park Sustainability Commission was called to order at 7:14 p.m. on Monday, February 10, 2014 at the La Grange Park Public Library in La Grange Park, Illinois.

1. Call to Order  
Commission Chair Krista Grimm called the meeting to order. Members present included: Donna Twickler, Jill Madison, and David Mrazek. Also present was Julia Cedillo, filling in as Village Staff Liaison.

The Commission could piggy-back with a “Green Ribbon” Clean Up, and request that residents get involved by assembling a green team to volunteer for the event.
