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# Village Board Meeting Fire Department Activity Memo

**Re:** Fire Department Activities – APRIL 2013

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As requested for insertion into the Village Board meeting agenda packet, the following is a brief summary of Fire Department activity highlights for the month of April. As usual, a more comprehensive monthly report is kept within the department for your review.

There were 135 EMS responses this month and 513 YTD. Last year, there were 396 YTD at this time. There were 64 fire/rescue incidents this month, and 169 YTD. Last year, there were 159 YTD at this time.

On April 15<sup>th</sup>, EMS personnel assisted with an Adopt-a-Cop presentation at Forest Road School.

On April 17<sup>th</sup>, EMS personnel assisted the Loyola EMS system and Broadview Fire Department by participating in an active shooter drill at the Loyola Hospital campus.

On April 18<sup>th</sup>, during the heavy rains, personnel responded to several incidents throughout the Village, including rotating fire companies to assist residents with filling sandbags. Various other calls in the Village included removing electrical and gas hazards from flooded basements, such as shutting off gas and electric to some homes. We also responded to assist other Villages, including responding with our Chief and an Engine to assist Brookfield with the fire at the Helping Hand Thrift Store on Grand Ave.

On April 21<sup>st</sup>, personnel participated and helped lead the Little League Parade with fire apparatus. During the parade, personnel also responded to two EMS requests in other areas of the Village.

**04/06 (SAT) 1:20 PM:** Responded to a car fire in a garage in the 600 block of Kensington. The resident was able to extinguish most of the fire prior to our arrival.

**04/17 (WED) 4:37 PM:** Responded with an Engine and Chief to assist La Grange with house fire caused by a lightning strike at 344 S. Stone Ave.

**04/18 (THUR) 4:13 PM:** The Duty Officer responded to drop equipment off for the Hinsdale Fire Department to assist them with evacuating a high-rise building during the flooding.

**04/21 (SUN) 9:05 AM:** Responded with an Engine to cover the Forest View fire station during a fire in one of their Village's heavily flooded areas. While in their Village, our personnel responded to two EMS calls, and a gasoline spill and natural gas leak in flooded buildings.

**04/24 (WED) 3:48 PM:** Responded to the Public Works building for smoke coming from an exhaust vent, which appeared to be caused by a bird's nest in the vent.

**04/27 (SAT) 7:56 PM:** Responded with an Engine and Chief to McCook for a MABAS level alarm for an explosion and fire at a metal cutting company. Our engine laid out 600' of hose to feed a ladder truck.

## EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES ACTIVITY REPORT – APRIL 2013

### Responses:

EMTs and Paramedics responded to 135 requests for emergency ambulance service this month rendering care to a total of 139 people. There were 102 incidents west of the IHB railroad and 20 east of the IHB railroad. Year to date, there has been a total of 513 requests for service with a total of 523 people receiving emergency care and/or transportation.

This compares to last year (April 2012) when there were a total of 130 requests for service during the month and a last year to date total of 396 requests for service.

### Training:

EMT continuing education was conducted on Tuesday, April 9<sup>th</sup> in the Community Room at Fire Station #1. Paramedics (EMT make up) had their continuing education on Monday, April 15<sup>th</sup>, Wednesday, April 17<sup>th</sup>, and Friday, April 19<sup>th</sup> at the LaGrange Fire Department.

Probationary Firefighters Cronin, Espitia, and Stelmack continued EMT-B training at Triton College in River Grove.

### Special Activities:

April 15<sup>th</sup> – Firefighters Baudler and Bink attended the Adopt-A-Cop Program at Forest Road School.

April 17<sup>th</sup> – Lieutenant Hurley and Firefighter Bink participated in a simulated “active shooter” drill conducted by the Loyola EMS System and the Broadview Fire Department held on the campus of Loyola Hospital near Maywood.






