


Re: Fire Department Activities – APRIL 2015

As requested for insertion into the Village Board meeting agenda packet, the following is a brief summary of Fire Department activity highlights for the month of April. As usual, a more comprehensive monthly report is kept within the department for your review.

EMS Responses for this month - 141. There have been 536 YTD compared to 494 YTD in 2014.
Fire/Rescue Incidents this month - 35. There have been 146 YTD compared to 208 YTD in 2014.

During the month, personnel provided two Fire Truck Ride to School activities. One included delivering the Brook Park principal to the school on the fire engine to help with a celebration for the job students did with their book fair.

During the month, two of our personnel attended portions of the Fire Department Instructors Conference International event in Indianapolis. This training conference and exhibition hosted nearly 32,000 attendees from 55 different countries. There is a myriad of some of the best fire service educational opportunities and speakers, a number of special events, and a display of the most modern and advanced fire protection equipment.

Fire Prevention and Safety Grants were completed and applied for during the month through the FEMA Assistance to Firefighters Grant program; one for a fire extinguisher training system, and the other for an Emergency Management guide to be developed for residents. It will most likely be several months until we hear something in relation to awards.

04/06 (MON) 4:50 PM: Responded to an activated fire alarm at Bethlehem Woods with the report of residents trapped in the elevator with smoke present! Upon arrival discovered residents were freed and smoke was in elevator mechanical room, due to overheated hydraulic oil.

04/09 (THUR) 7:55 AM: Responded to power lines that came down due to lighting strike on 30th St., between Blanchan and Cleveland. The lines came down and landed on a garage, play fort, and fence, and substantially arced in the street, creating a large hole. The FD made contact with area residents, and secured the site, until ComEd could respond and isolate the power.

04/09 (THUR) 7:02 PM: Responded to an odor of gas in front of a home in the 1500 block of Morgan. Odor was identified as coming from gas lamp. Personnel shut down the valve on the gas line to the lamp.

04/19 (SUN) 8:10 AM: Responded to a home in the 1400 block of Beach for the smell of smoke. Upon arrival discovered a problem with the electrical receptacle where the microwave was plugged in. Personnel shut off the circuit feeding the receptacle.

04/21 (TUE) 10:04 AM: Responded for a natural gas odor in the basement. Upon investigation discovered a valve on a gas line no longer being used partially open. Nicor was contacted to respond and properly cap/secure line.

EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES ACTIVITY REPORT – APRIL 2015

Ambulance Responses:

This month, EMT and Paramedic personnel responded to a total of 141 requests for emergency medical services treating a total of 141 patients. There were 100 calls located west of the IHB Railroad and 26 calls east of the IHB Railroad. Year to date, there has been a total of 536 requests for service providing care to 540 patients.

This compares to last year (April 2014) when there were 106 requests for service with a year to date total of 494 service requests.

Training and Continuing Education:

EMT Continuing Education conducted by the Loyola EMS System through our Associate Hospital – LaGrange Memorial, was conducted on Tuesday, April 14th in the Community Room at Fire Station #1. Paramedic Continuing Education was conducted on Monday, April 20th, Wednesday, April 22nd, and Friday, April 24th at the LaGrange Fire Department.


Firefighter/Paramedic Carbone attended an update seminar at LaGrange Hospital on New Street Drugs.
