


Re: Fire Department Activities – APRIL 2014

As requested for insertion into the Village Board meeting agenda packet, the following is a brief summary of Fire Department activity highlights for the month of April. As usual, a more comprehensive monthly report is kept within the department for your review.

There were 106 EMS responses this month and 494 YTD. Last year, there were 513 YTD at this time. There were 21 fire/rescue incidents this month, and 208 YTD. Last year, there were 169 YTD at this time.

During the month, final occupancy inspections were conducted by Fire Prevention staff for homes located at 1650 Finsbury, 21 Brewster, and 630 N. Kensington. A final fire alarm test was conducted at the home at 1 Stonegate. Fire sprinkler inspections were also conducted for the home at 1634 Finsbury, and for the Fruitful Yield space at 425 N. La Grange Rd.

A public education first-aid event was conducted for a group of girl scouts during the month.

Our personnel worked on renovations at Fire Station 2, including renovating the main restroom, which finish and design dated back to 1957. Also, the adjoining dayroom was painted and carpeted. These small projects, done mostly by our own personnel, really turned out nice.

Personnel attended two separate safety presentations by IRMA regarding compliance with laws and best practices for Lock-out / Tag-out operations.

Personnel attended the Fire Department Instructors Conference in Indianapolis. It is regarded as the world's largest firefighter training conference.

04/09 (WED) 5:26 PM: Responded for a bicyclist struck by an auto at 31st and Edgewood.

04/21 (MON) 3:29 PM: Responded to a cooking fire involving a toaster at a home in the 500 block of Kemman. Due to the amount of smoke, one occupant had to be evaluated by EMS.



EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES ACTIVITY REPORT – APRIL 2014

Ambulance Responses:

This month, EMT and Paramedic personnel responded to a total of 106 requests for emergency medical services treating a total of 109 patients. There were 82 calls located west of the IHB Railroad and 13 calls east of the IHB Railroad. Year to date, there have been a total of 494 requests for service and 507 patients receiving care.

This compares to last year (April 2013) when there were 135 requests for service and a year to date total of 513 calls.

Training and Continuing Education:

EMT Continuing Education conducted by the Loyola EMS System through our Associate Hospital – LaGrange Memorial, was conducted on Tuesday, April 8th in the Community Room at Fire Station #1. Paramedic Continuing Education was conducted on Monday, April 14th, Wednesday, April 16th, and Friday, April 18th at the LaGrange Fire Department.

Special Activities:

On April 12th, members provided ambulance and paramedic coverage for the Community Park District at Memorial Park during their visit by Governor Pat Quinn announcing Statewide Park District Grants.
