Re: Fire Department Activities – DECEMBER 2014

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As requested for insertion into the Village Board meeting agenda packet, the following is a brief summary of Fire Department activity highlights for the month of December. As usual, a more comprehensive monthly report is kept within the department for your review.

There were 173 EMS responses this month and 1652 YTD. Last year, there were 1520 YTD at this time. There were 33 fire/rescue incidents this month, and 496 YTD. Last year, there were 471 YTD at this time.

Early in the week, grant applications were completely and submitted to FEMA, for the federal Assistance to Firefighter Grant program. We have again applied for a grant for a new Ladder Truck, along with other equipment.

During the month, we met with School District 95 to assist in reviewing their Crisis Response Plan.

During the month, our Fire Station 1 Dayroom and Watch Office were painted, with some very minor remodeling taking place. All of the work was completed by our own employees, with most of it done by contract paramedic/firefighter John Dietrich, who completed most of it on his regular shift days.

Personnel participated in the Annual Holiday in the Park event at the Community Park District. We delivered Santa on one of our Engines, distributed fire safety information, and provided a Holiday Fire Safety demonstration

12/04 (THUR) 10:14 AM: Responded with a Hazardous Materials Technician and Ambulance to assist the Forest View Fire Department with a Hazardous Materials incident in the 5400 block of 47<sup>th</sup> St. One of our Engines also assisted by covering their station and Village during the incident.

12/25 (THUR) 1:28 PM: Responded to a four vehicle car crash at the intersection of 31<sup>st</sup> and La Grange Rd. One of the severely damaged vehicles went off of the roadway, knocked down a traffic signal and light pole, damaged the BP sign, and ended up coming to rest in the parking lot. Based upon the extent of the damage to the vehicle, one occupant had to be cut out of the car using hydraulic rescue tools in order to safely remove her. A MABAS box alarm for EMS was requested, bringing in ambulances from various other Fire Departments. In addition to evaluating six patients and transporting three to area hospitals, we brought a severely injured dog to a local animal hospital, who appeared to have been ejected from one of the cars. Unfortunately the dog passed away from its' injuries at the animal hospital.



## EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES ACTIVITY REPORT – DECEMBER 2014

### Ambulance Responses:

This month, EMT and Paramedic personnel responded to a total of 173 requests for emergency medical services treating a total of 181 patients. There were 138 calls located west of the IHB Railroad and 24 calls east of the IHB Railroad. Year to date, there have been a total of 1652 requests for service and 1686 patients receiving care.

This compares to last year (December 2013) when there were 144 requests for service and a year to date total of 1520 calls.

### Training and Continuing Education:

Fire Department members received training and education in Infection Control measures including the response to the outbreak of the seasonal flu.

### Special Activities:

Fire Department members continue to monitor the Ebola Outbreak.






