Re: Fire Department Activities – JUNE 2013

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As requested for insertion into the Village Board meeting agenda packet, the following is a brief summary of Fire Department activity highlights for the month of June. As usual, a more comprehensive monthly report is kept within the department for your review.

There were 123 EMS responses this month and 771 YTD. Last year, there were 725 YTD at this time. There were 44 fire/rescue incidents this month, and 255 YTD. Last year, there were 232 YTD at this time.

During the month, personnel participated in many public education and relations activities. On June 1<sup>st</sup>, personnel participated in the Pet Parade, and on June 8<sup>th</sup>, personnel participated in the La Grange Park Chamber of Commerce Bike Fest. Also, on June 20<sup>th</sup>, personnel participated in the Plymouth Place Health Care Fair, and during the month, personnel also attended three block parties.

Personnel continued to flush fire hydrants in the Village. As of the end of June, approximately three quarters of our hydrants in the Village have been inspected and flushed.

During the month, the Fire Chief participated in Fire Service Home Day which took place at the College of DuPage. This is an event where various legislators and their staffers are invited to discuss current concerns and needs of the fire service. They area also given a chance receive education regarding, and actually operate, various tools and equipment currently used by the fire service.

## EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES ACTIVITY REPORT – JUNE 2013

### Ambulance Responses:

This month, EMT and Paramedic personnel responded to a total of 123 requests for emergency medical services treating a total of 128 patients. There were 96 calls located west of the IHB Railroad and 19 calls east of the IHB Railroad. Year to date, there have been a total of 771 requests for service and 792 patients receiving care.


This compares to last year (June 2012) when there were 114 requests for service and a year to date total of 725 calls.


### Training and Continuing Education:
