Re: Fire Department Activities – MAY 2016

As requested for insertion into the Village Board meeting agenda packet, the following is a brief summary of Fire Department activity highlights for the month of May. As usual, a more comprehensive monthly report is kept within the department for your review.

EMS Responses for this month - 151. There have been 698 YTD compared to 712 YTD in 2015.
Fire/Rescue Incidents this month - 50. There have been 184 YTD compared to 192 YTD in 2015.

On May 12th, many of our personnel attended the Brookfield-La Grange Park Lions Club Dinner where PSSI contract Paramedic/Firefighter John Dietrich was awarded the 2015 Firefighter-of-the-Year.

On May 13th, seven of our personnel were recognized at the Loyola EMS Recognition Breakfast for two separate incidents in 2015, saving the lives of two of our residents who suffered cardiac arrests.

On May 14th, Fire/EMS personnel stood-by during the Annual Run for the Roses.

On May 15th, a couple of our personnel attended the Opening Day Ceremonies of the Little League. Also, on May 29th, personnel attended the Memorial Day ceremony at the Veterans Memorial Wall.

On May 21st, personnel participated in a MABAS Division 10 Haz-Mat Incident Drill in Hinsdale where illegal dumping of hazardous chemicals was simulated, sickening two simulated victims. Haz-Mat Techs had to control the spills, and the two "victims" had to be decontaminated and transported to hospitals.

During the month, the Truck/Quint Purchasing Committee and various other personnel began to evaluate vehicles built by various manufacturers. We hosted a number of presentations and demonstrations to assess capabilities, design, craftsmanship, etc.

At least two significant vehicle crashes occurred during the month; one taking down a street light in the 600 block of La Grange Rd., and another where a vehicle rolled over at 31st St. and Homestead Rd. Also during the month, there were three responses for natural gas leaks inside homes; two for stoves that were leaking, and one involved a leaking gas pipe in a closet that was feeding an outdoor grill.

May 5th Thur at 1:50 pm: Chief responded to assist Brookfield with house fire in the 4200 block of Forest.

May 14th Sat at 1:51 pm: Response to a basement fire in the 900 block of Beach Ave. Occupants extinguished most of the fire with a fire extinguisher prior to arrival.

May 17th Tue at 2:26 pm: A Hazardous Materials Technician and Chief responded to a chlorine leak at the Darien Water Treatment plant on Plainfield west of Cass as part of a MABAS 10 Haz-Mat Team response. The immediate area was evacuated and a team made entry to control the leak.

EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES ACTIVITY REPORT – MAY 2016

Ambulance Responses:

This month, EMT and Paramedic personnel responded to a total of 151 requests for emergency medical services treating a total of 153 patients. There were 105 calls located west of the IHB Railroad and 33 calls east of the IHB Railroad. Year to date, there has been a total of 698 requests for service treated 704 patients.

This compares to last year (May 2015) when there were 176 requests for service with a year to date total of 712 responses.

Training and Continuing Education:

EMT Continuing Education conducted by the Loyola EMS System through our Associate Hospital – LaGrange Memorial, was conducted on Tuesday, May 10th in the Community Room at Fire Station #1. Paramedic Continuing Education was conducted on Monday, May 16th, Wednesday, May 18th, and Friday, May 20th at the LaGrange Fire Department.

Probationary Firefighter Stelmos is currently attending EMT-B training at Triton College in River Grove.

All members completed mandatory continuing education on the updated Illinois EMS Region 8 standing medical orders. This also included an EMS skills review practical. These are set to go into effect on July 1, 2016.

Lt. Storey and Firefighter Dahl participated in the MABAS Division 10 Hazardous Materials Response Drill hosted by the Hinsdale Fire Department. Our members staffed our second response ambulance "transporting" a person exposed to an unknown chemical to Hinsdale Hospital for "treatment".

Special Activities:

Fire Department members provided paramedic/ambulance coverage for the Park District's Annual Run for the Roses Race through LaGrange Park. Both paramedic ambulances and a first response engine were on stand-by. Fortunately, our services were not needed.

As May is Emergency Medical Services Appreciation month, several area hospitals provided appreciation programs including AMITA LaGrange, AMITA Hinsdale, and Advocate Good Samaritan Hospitals.

Also as part of EMS Appreciation month, the Loyola EMS System held their annual Recognition Breakfast at the Brookfield Zoo. Our personnel received an award for excellence in providing emergency care during the past year.


