Re: Fire Department Activities – MAY 2013

As requested for insertion into the Village Board meeting agenda packet, the following is a brief summary of Fire Department activity highlights for the month of May. As usual, a more comprehensive monthly report is kept within the department for your review.

There were 135 EMS responses this month and 648 YTD. Last year, there were 611 YTD at this time. There were 42 fire/rescue incidents this month, and 211 YTD. Last year, there were 198 YTD at this time.

During the month, personnel began to flush fire hydrants in the Village. A portion of the Village is done on a regular basis during the year. Personnel assisted with six school evacuation drills throughout the month.

On May 15th, personnel participated in a panel discussion regarding senior issues, and end of life planning at Plymouth Place. We assisted with the portion of the discussion regarding Advanced Medical Directives and Do Not Resuscitate Orders from an EMS perspective, and rules regarding the use of such in the field.

Also on May 15th, some personnel attended the Lions Club Awards Dinner, where Lieutenant Steve Tullis was awarded the 2012 Lions Club Firefighter of the Year. The Lions Club also presented the Fire Department with a \$985.00 check to purchase a new ventilation and rescue saw.

On May 18th, personnel stood-by during Run for the Roses with both ambulances to provide EMS coverage throughout the race.

On May 21st, Fire Department personnel conducted training with representatives of ComEd at their substation on Barnsdale Rd., north of 31st St.

On May 22nd, as part of Celebrating Seniors Week, we provided a short Fire and Fall Prevention presentation to a small group of seniors in our Village Board room.

05/06 (MON) 3:34 PM: Responded to the library and helped free a three year old child who was stuck in the elevator on the lower level.

05/17 (FRI) 9:22 PM: Responded to Brook-Park School to assist with evaluating natural gas inside the school where a stove burner was left on after hours.

05/28 (TUE) 11:40 AM: Responded with an Engine to assist Stone Park with a MABAS level alarm for a significant fire at a supermarket and apartment building in the 1600 block of Manheim Rd.

05/28 (TUE) 8:10 PM: Responded to multiple incidents during a storm. One incident involved a power line that came down and was arcing in the 1200 block of Homestead, and which energized and damaged a home. Also, several power lines came down on Woodlawn east of the Village Hall.

EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES ACTIVITY REPORT – MAY 2013

Responses:

EMTs and Paramedics responded to 135 requests for emergency ambulance service this month rendering care to a total of 141 people. There were 98 incidents west of the IHB railroad and 25 east of the IHB railroad. Year to date, there has been a total of 648 requests for service with a total of 664 people receiving emergency care and/or transportation.

This compares to last year (May 2012) when there were a total of 123 requests for service during the month and a last year to date total of 611 requests for service.

Training:

Members completed the EMS Continuing Education Program conducted by the Loyola EMS System in April and used the month of May to make up any outstanding continuing education requirements. Regular monthly CE starts up again in July.

Probationary Firefighters Cronin, Espitia, and Stelmack completed EMT-B training at Triton College in River Grove and are scheduled to take their State licensure exam in June.

Special Activities:

On May 15th, Chief Maggos attended an open forum question and answer discussion at Plymouth Place regarding the new End of Life Advanced Directives and Do Not Resuscitate Orders from the State of Illinois.

On May 18th, Lt. Gruszka, Firefighter/Paramedics Bink, Dietrich, Mahn, and Wittman, and Firefighter/EMTs Hacholski, Heuer, Michalski, and Raupp provided ambulance and paramedic coverage for the Park District's Annual Run for the Roses Race through LaGrange Park.






