Re: Fire Department Activities – MAY 2014

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As requested for insertion into the Village Board meeting agenda packet, the following is a brief summary of Fire Department activity highlights for the month of May. As usual, a more comprehensive monthly report is kept within the department for your review.

There were 140 EMS responses this month and 634 YTD. Last year, there were 645 YTD at this time. There were 41 fire/rescue incidents this month, and 249 YTD. Last year, there were 211 YTD at this time.

During the month, personnel participated in various public education and/or community events including the following: the Little League Parade; the Reddy Teddy end of year program; two "fire truck ride to school" programs; fire safety presentations for several classes at Forest Rd. School; one block party; and the Pet Parade.

EMS coverage was also provided for the annual Run for the Roses, and we assisted La Grange with standing by with an ambulance and engine during the Pet Parade.

Staff conducted fire evacuation drills at all Village schools, and Fire Prevention Division Chief Carpenter witnessed a fire evacuation drill for employees at the Bethlehem Woods complex.

A final occupancy fire inspection was conducted for The Fruitful Yield, and a final occupancy fire inspection and fire alarm system test was conducted for Amusement Bark. Also, final residential occupancy fire inspections were conducted for new homes at 1660 Finsbury and 312 Waiola.

05/13 (TUE) 10:07 AM: Responded to an activated fire alarm at Bethlehem Woods Commons Building. Upon arrival fire companies found smoke from an overheating elevator motor activated smoke detector.

05/16 (FRI) 5:45 PM: Responded to fuel spill at 31<sup>st</sup> St. and La Grange Rd., where a gravel truck's fuel line ruptured.

05/26 (MON) 8:14 AM: Responded to Plymouth Place where two occupants were trapped in the service elevator. Fire crews were able to open doors and free the occupants.

05/29 (THUR) 8:02 AM: Responded to a natural gas service that was struck by contractors and leaking gas in front of 305 Edgewood. Fire companies stood-by until Nicor arrived to secure the leak.



## EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES ACTIVITY REPORT – MAY 2014

### **Ambulance Responses:**

This month, EMT and Paramedic personnel responded to a total of 140 requests for emergency medical services treating a total of 138 patients. Year to date, there have been a total of 634 requests for service and 645 patients receiving care.

This compares to last year (May 2013) when there were 135 requests for service and a year to date total of 648 calls.

### **Training and Continuing Education:**

There was no scheduled EMT or Paramedic continuing education in May.

Probationary Firefighter Kyle Kudia began EMT-B training at the College of DuPage in Glen Ellyn.

### **Special Activities:**

On May 6<sup>th</sup>, our Department hosted the quarterly EMS System Coordinators Meeting for the Loyola Hospital EMS System. Firefighter/Paramedic Baudler represented our Department.


In May, Firefighters Czml and Palicka completed re-licensure requirements through the Illinois Department of Public Health and the Loyola Hospital EMS System.
