Re: Fire Department Activities – OCTOBER 2014

As requested for insertion into the Village Board meeting agenda packet, the following is a brief summary of Fire Department activity highlights for the month of October. As usual, a more comprehensive monthly report is kept within the department for your review.

There were 153 EMS responses this month and 1329 YTD. Last year, there were 1251 YTD at this time. There were 42 fire/rescue incidents this month, and 431 YTD. Last year, there were 390 YTD at this time.

On October 12th, our Annual Open House was held at Fire Station No. 1, providing a great amount of fire and safety education to children and adults alike. Also during the month, many events related to Fire Prevention Week also took place, including presenting fire safety education at all elementary schools, and to seniors at Bethlehem Woods. Firefighters also staffed Fire Station 2 during the Chamber of Commerce Haunted Trolley Trick or Treat event.

Personnel were presented with the "EMS Run of the Month" for September from Adventist La Grange Hospital for the care and treatment they provided for a cardiac patient. Also during the month, the Fire Department provided EMS coverage for two Nazareth Football games.

Throughout the month, personnel trained using a house at 246 Kings Ct. which was slated for demolition.

Also during the month, personnel participated in regional planning with neighboring communities to prepare for the treatment and transport of patients who are suspect of having the Ebola virus.

10/23 (THUR) 11:33 PM: Responded to an activated fire alarm, which turned out to be a cooking fire, at 1602 Homestead Rd. Fire was confined to the container, and firefighters assisted with removing smoke.

10/26 (SUN) 5:27 AM: Responded with an Engine, Plans Chief and Investigator to assist the Forest View Fire Department with the MABAS box alarm house fire at 4529 Home Ave.

10/27 (MON) 3:24 PM: Responded to a fireplace natural gas leak at a home in the 1200 block of Woodside. Firefighters were able to control the leak by closing a valve in the system.

10/29 (WED) 4:17 AM: Responded with our Truck, and a Safety Section Officer (Chief), to assist the Hinsdale Fire Department with a MABAS box alarm house fire at 925 S. Bodin Ave.

10/29 (WED) 7:57 AM: Responded to an activated carbon monoxide detector at a home in the 900 block of Kemman. Elevated levels of CO were discovered, coming from a stove in the home.

10/30 (THUR) 4:44 PM: Responded for an odor of gasoline in a home in the 900 block of N. Stone. Upon investigation it was discovered that a neighbor poured a small amount of gasoline into a catch basin at the end of the block. Firefighters flushed the sewer system with water to dissipate the gasoline and odor.



EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES ACTIVITY REPORT – OCTOBER 2014

Ambulance Responses:

This month, EMT and Paramedic personnel responded to a total of 153 requests for emergency medical services treating a total of 159 patients. There were 122 calls located west of the IHB Railroad and 25 calls east of the IHB Railroad. Year to date, there have been a total of 1329 requests for service and 1354 patients receiving care.

This compares to last year (October 2013) when there were 142 requests for service and a year to date total of 1251 calls.

Training and Continuing Education:

EMT Continuing Education was conducted on Tuesday, October 14th in the Community Room at Fire Station #1. Paramedic Continuing Education was held on Monday, October 13th, Tuesday, October 14th, and Wednesday, October 15th at the LaGrange Fire Department.






