Re: Fire Department Activities – FEBRUARY 2014

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As requested for insertion into the Village Board meeting agenda packet, the following is a brief summary of Fire Department activity highlights for the month of February. As usual, a more comprehensive monthly report is kept within the department for your review.

There were 118 EMS responses this month, compared to 121 in February of 2013. Year-to-date, there have been 261 EMS responses, compared to 276 responses during the same period in 2013.

There were 58 fire/rescue incidents this month, compared to 27 in February of 2013. Year-to-date, there have been 138 incidents compared to 72 during the same time period in 2013.

Once again, due to impending extreme weather, both fire stations were staffed on February 1<sup>st</sup> by paid-on-call personnel to ensure an adequate and timely response.

On February 12<sup>th</sup>, personnel conducted a Community CPR class in conjunction with the Park District.

During the month, our Fire Prevention Division Chief witnessed the fire sprinkler hydrostatic test and fire pump test for the new addition at Deslauriers, located at 1245 Barnsdale Rd.

Final testing of the fire alarm and sprinkler systems took place at 1 Stonegate Rd., which is a newly renovated residence owned by Helping Hand.

**02/02 (SUN) 1:23 PM:** Responded to 601 N. Ashland for a natural gas leak in a condo unit which occurred when a gas line broke as resident was moving her stove. Crews assisted with shutting down the gas and ventilating the building.

**02/18 (TUE) 6:38 AM:** Responded with an engine and chief to assist the Brookfield Fire Department with a house fire in the 4100 block of Sunnyside Ave.

**02/19 (WED) 3:36 PM:** Responded to 525 N. Kensington for a house fire. Upon arrival, the basement was already heavily involved in fire, and traveling throughout the home. The incident was quickly elevated to a MABAS box alarm which brought assistance from various neighboring fire departments.

**02/22 (SAT) 5:41 PM:** Responded with a fire investigator to assist the Riverside Fire Department with an apartment fire at 2916 Harlem Ave.

## EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES ACTIVITY REPORT – FEBRUARY 2014

### Ambulance Responses:

This month, EMT and Paramedic personnel responded to a total of 118 requests for emergency medical services treating a total of 122 patients. There were 95 calls located west of the IHB Railroad and 16 calls east of the IHB Railroad. Year to date, there have been a total of 261 requests for service and 269 patients receiving care.

This compares to last year (February 2013) when there were 121 requests for service and a year to date total of 276 calls.

### Training and Continuing Education:

EMT Continuing Education conducted by the Loyola EMS System through our Associate Hospital – LaGrange Memorial, was conducted on Tuesday, February 11<sup>th</sup> in the Community Room at Fire Station #1. Paramedic Continuing Education was conducted on Monday, February 10<sup>th</sup>, Wednesday, February 12<sup>th</sup>, and Friday, February 14<sup>th</sup> at the LaGrange Fire Department.

### Special Activities:

On February 12<sup>th</sup>, Firefighters Bink and Mahn conducted a Community CPR Class in conjunction with the Community Park District in the Community Room at Fire Station #1. There were 8 people present at this Heartsaver AED class.






