Re: Fire Department Activities – JULY 2014

As requested for insertion into the Village Board meeting agenda packet, the following is a brief summary of Fire Department activity highlights for the month of July. As usual, a more comprehensive monthly report is kept within the department for your review.

There were 134 EMS responses this month and 903 YTD. Last year, there were 862 YTD at this time. There were 40 fire/rescue incidents this month, and 321 YTD. Last year, there were 292 YTD at this time.

A final fire occupancy inspection was conducted for the new home at 1634 Finsbury, and the commercial addition at 1245 Barnsdale. A final inspection of a new fire alarm system was also conducted for the apartment building at 420 Beach. Fire Prevention staff also conducted planning and inspections for the St. Louise SummerFest event.

Division Chief Carpenter and Fire Inspector McManus attended an IL State Fire Marshal sponsored course regarding school inspections. Local inspectors must attend such course and be approved to conduct the safety inspections of schools.

The Fire Department responded to two fireworks related events on July 4th. One was for heavy smoke in the area of Brainard and 31st, which was caused by the heavy use of fireworks at nearby home in Westchester. The other was to extinguish a fireworks debris left burning in the street at 26th and Kemman.

Twice this month, we were called to extinguish mulch fires in front of businesses in the 900 block of 31st.

During the month, the Fire Department was requested to investigate the odor of smoke at a home in the 1400 block of Stonegate. During the investigation, it was discovered the odor was actually that of a skunk.

Personnel participated in various Independence Day parades in neighboring Villages.

07/07 (MON) 6:27 AM: Responded to investigate smoke in the Cook County Highway Department administration building. It was caused by a problem with a rooftop HVAC unit.

07/14 (MON) 8:31 PM: Responded to investigate smoke in the basement of a home in 1400 block of Deerpath. It was caused by an overheated washing machine.

07/28 (MON) 2:29 AM: Responded with a fire investigator to assist Riverside at the scene of a house fire.



EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES ACTIVITY REPORT – JULY 2014

Ambulance Responses:

This month, EMT and Paramedic personnel responded to a total of 134 requests for emergency medical services treating a total of 138 patients. There were 106 calls located west of the IHB Railroad and 18 calls east of the IHB Railroad. Year to date, there have been a total of 903 requests for service and 920 patients receiving care.

This compares to last year (July 2013) when there were 159 requests for service and a year to date total of 862 calls.

Training and Continuing Education:

EMT Continuing Education was conducted on Tuesday, July 8th in the Community Room at Fire Station #1. Paramedic Continuing Education was held on Monday, July 14th, Wednesday, July 16th, and Friday, July 18th at the LaGrange Fire Department.

Probationary Firefighter Kyle Kudia continues EMT-B training at the College of DuPage in Glen Ellyn.






