Re: Fire Department Activities – JANUARY 2013

As requested for insertion into the Village Board meeting agenda packet, the following is a brief summary of Fire Department activity highlights for the month of January. As usual, a more comprehensive monthly report is kept within the department for your review.

There were 155 EMS responses this month, compared to 103 in January of 2012.
There were 45 fire/rescue incidents this month, compared to 34 in January of 2012.

During the month, most personnel were re-trained and re-certified in CPR and AED use.

Personnel participated in a Welcome Home event at Brook-Park School for a soldier. His son is a student there and he came to celebrate his son's birthday; the first time he has been home for such in four years.

Personnel conducted fire prevention and first-aid educational programs for three separate groups of Boys Scouts, Girl Scouts and Brownies during the month.

Personnel witnessed the flushing of the water supply line for the new fire sprinkler system being installed at 1126-1130 Maple Ave.

Personnel witnessed the acceptance testing of a new fire alarm system installed for a new business located at 1018 E. 31st St.

01/09 (WED) 8:36 AM: Responded for a report of smoke in a home in the 700 block of Forest Rd. which turned out to an overheating motor on a washing machine.

01/11 (FRI) 5:13 PM: Responded with our ladder truck and investigator to assist the Pleasantview Fire District with a MABAS Box alarm for a house fire on Pontiac Drive in Indian Head Park.

01/12 (SAT) 5:41 PM: Responded with our ladder truck and Chief to assist the Hinsdale Fire Department with a MABAS Box alarm for a house fire on 57th St.

01/14 (MON) 5:03 PM: Responded for a gas leak in a home in the 500 block of Park. A gas line had been severed which feeds a fireplace. Fire companies removed on the scene for over an hour ventilating the home to remove the gas.

01/28 (MON) 7:46 AM: Responded for a carbon monoxide alarm at a home in the 1000 block of Meadowcrest Rd. Upon arrival, fire companies found high levels of CO, most likely related to a car that had been left running the garage.

EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES ACTIVITY REPORT FOR JANUARY 2013

Ambulance Response:

During the month, our EMTs and Paramedics responded to 155 requests for service rendering care to 159 people. Of the service requests, 126 were located west and 16 were located east of the IHB Railroad.

This compares to last year (January 2012) when there were 103 requests for service rendering care to 107 people.

Training:

EMT continuing education took place on Tuesday, January 8th in the Community Room at Fire Station #1 while Paramedic continuing education (EMT make-up) took place on Monday, January 14th, Wednesday, January 16th, and Friday, January 18th in conjunction with the LaGrange Fire Department at their station.

On January 21st & 22nd, our Department CPR and AED Instructors recertified all the members of the Fire Department in CPR and AED procedures.

Probationary Firefighters Cronin, Espitia, and Stelmack began EMT-B training at Triton College in River Grove. This training toward State licensure will run through May.

Special Activities:

On January 7th, Firefighter/Paramedic Baudler attended the regular meeting of the Loyola Electronic Reporting Committee. This was held at the Broadview Fire Department.

On January 14th, Firefighter/Paramedic Baudler attended the annual Update Seminar for Department EMS Coordinators at the Loyola EMS System Office at Loyola Medical Center.

On January 15th, Firefighter/Paramedic Baudler attended the regular meeting of Department EMS Coordinators in the Loyola EMS System. This was also held at the Broadview Fire Department.






