Re: Fire Department Activities – SEPTEMBER 2014

As requested for insertion into the Village Board meeting agenda packet, the following is a brief summary of Fire Department activity highlights for the month of September. As usual, a more comprehensive monthly report is kept within the department for your review.

There were 149 EMS responses this month and 1176 YTD. Last year, there were 1109 YTD at this time. There were 35 fire/rescue incidents this month, and 389 YTD. Last year, there were 355 YTD at this time.

On September 8th, during the Fire Department's regularly scheduled training session, Fire Department retirees were invited to attend where they were recognized and remembered for their service.

During the month, Fire Department personnel assisted with fire evacuation drills in all schools. Also, a fire station tour and public education event was conducted for preschool children from Grace Lutheran Church. Personnel also attended 30 block parties during the month.

Fire Department personnel attended various remembrance ceremonies on September 11th, including a luncheon at Plymouth Place, and events at Bethlehem Woods and the North Riverside Fire Department.

During the month, our Fire Department sent an engine and personnel to assist the Pleasantview Fire Protection District with covering their response areas while they held services for a long time firefighter of the District, who passed away.

09/08 (MON) 4:54 PM: Responded to 329 Malden for a fire in an oven. Firefighters arrived and extinguished fire with a fire extinguisher, and assisted with removing smoke from the house. La Grange firefighters assisted with the incident.

09/27 (SAT) 10:07 AM: Responded to a truck fire in front of 1215 E. 31st St. The fire was extinguished with a fire extinguisher prior to Fire Department arrival.

EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES ACTIVITY REPORT – SEPTEMBER 2014

Ambulance Responses:

This month, EMT and Paramedic personnel responded to a total of 149 requests for emergency medical services treating a total of 150 patients. There were 114 calls located west of the IHB Railroad and 23 calls east of the IHB Railroad. Year to date, there have been a total of 1176 requests for service and 1195 patients receiving care.

This compares to last year (September 2013) when there were 118 requests for service and a year to date total of 1109 calls.

Training and Continuing Education:

EMT Continuing Education was conducted on Tuesday, September 9th in the Community Room at Fire Station #1. Paramedic Continuing Education was held on Monday, September 15th, Tuesday, September 16th, and Wednesday, September 17th at the LaGrange Fire Department.

Probationary Firefighter Kyle Kudia continues EMT-B training at the College of DuPage in Glen Ellyn.

Special Activities:

On September 6th, Firefighter/Paramedic Mahn and Firefighter Rosicky provided ambulance and paramedic service at the Nazareth High School Football Game.

On September 20th, Firefighter/Paramedic Wittman and Firefighter Drake provided ambulance and paramedic service at the Nazareth High School Football Game.

In September, our new contract Firefighter/Paramedic Nick Elfter started on shift filling an opening when one of our members left in August.
