Re: Fire Department Activities – SEPTEMBER 2013

As requested for insertion into the Village Board meeting agenda packet, the following is a brief summary of Fire Department activity highlights for the month of September. As usual, a more comprehensive monthly report is kept within the department for your review.

There were 118 EMS responses this month and 1109 YTD. Last year, there were 1090 YTD at this time. There were 28 fire/rescue incidents this month, and 355 YTD. Last year, there were 370 YTD at this time.

Personnel participated in 23 block parties throughout the month, and conducted fire safety presentations for Cub Scouts at Brook-Park School, and for a preschool group who came to the fire station. Also, fire evacuation drills were conducted throughout Village schools.

Fire Prevention staff witnessed the hydrostatic pressure testing for the new fire sprinkler system at the Public Works facility, and for two sprinkler systems in single-family homes in the Heatherdale subdivision.

On September 9th, the Fire Chief participated in a webinar provided by one of FEMA's regional grant specialist, which provided training related to the annual federal Assistance to Firefighters' Grant program. In past years we have been very successful with this program in obtaining equipment and improving facilities, and we continue to apply for funding for our ladder truck through the program.

On September 29th, many of our personnel conducted live fire training at the Broadview Fire Department burn tower. Newer personnel were exposed to actual fire and smoke conditions, and were able to train with and operate various tools and equipment.

EMS personnel assisted with providing ALS ambulance coverage for two Nazareth Football games.

09/02 (MON) 3:05 PM: Responded to an activated carbon monoxide detector at an apartment building in the 1200 block of La Grange Rd. Slightly elevated levels of CO were found due to a problem with a dryer.

09/15 (SUN) 2:33 AM: Responded with a Plans Chief on the MABAS alarm to assist Westmont with a structure fire.

09/16 (MON) 10:28 PM: Responded to assist with a fire on Archer Ave. in Willow Springs. A fire investigator was sent to the scene and our ambulance stood by in their station.

09/18 (WED) 10:19 PM: Responded to a report of smoke in a home in the 700 block of Forest Rd. Upon arrival found the smoke was related to an arcing electrical receptacle in the home.

EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES ACTIVITY REPORT – SEPTEMBER 2013

Ambulance Responses:

This month, EMT and Paramedic personnel responded to a total of 118 requests for emergency medical services treating a total of 117 patients. There were 89 calls located west of the IHB Railroad and 20 calls east of the IHB Railroad. Year to date, there have been a total of 1109 requests for service and 1138 patients receiving care.

This compares to last year (September 2012) when there were 107 requests for service and a year to date total of 1090 calls.

Training and Continuing Education:

EMT Continuing Education, conducted by LaGrange Memorial Hospital through the Loyola EMS System, was held on Tuesday, September 10th in the Community Room at Fire Station #1. Paramedic Continuing Education was conducted on Monday, September 16th, Wednesday, September 18th, and Friday, September 20th at the LaGrange Fire Department.

September 7th – Firefighters Wittman and Rosicky provided ambulance and paramedic coverage at the Nazareth High School football game.






