Re: Fire Department Activities – JUNE 2015

As requested for insertion into the Village Board meeting agenda packet, the following is a brief summary of Fire Department activity highlights for the month of June. As usual, a more comprehensive monthly report is kept within the department for your review.

EMS Responses for this month - 156. There have been 868 YTD compared to 782 YTD in 2014.
Fire/Rescue Incidents this month - 44. There have been 236 YTD compared to 231 YTD in 2014.

Personnel provided a fire truck display for the Chamber of Commerce Bike Fest on June 6th. Also, hydrant flushing/inspection continued during the month, with now approximately two-thirds of the Village being completed.

On June 14th, a graduation ceremony took place for our six candidates for the Fire Academy being hosted at the Western Springs Fire Department. Our six graduates are Andy Chorley, Matt Dahl, Mike Hughes, Josh Johnsen, Matt Joyce and Jon Mohr.

Firefighters completed constructing and installing new lockers at both fire stations to hold turnout gear. The new metal lockers are replacing very old small wooden lockers that existed, and allow for much better air flow to ventilate and dry the equipment stored in them. This substantial purchase was made possible through our Foreign Fire Insurance Fund.

06/13 (SAT) 9:08 PM: Responded for power lines that came down across La Grange Rd. at Woodlawn. Personnel assisted securing area until ComEd arrived. A similar incident occurred again on 06/21 at 6:17 am.

06/15 (MON) 1:49 PM: Responded to a gas line cut by a landscaper at 29 Brewster Ave. Firefighters worked on the line and stopped the leak, and stood by until Nicor arrived.

06/16 (TUE) 8:03 PM: Responded with an Engine, Chief and Investigator to assist La Grange with a garage fire at 102 Blackstone Ave.

06/18 (THUR) 8:11 PM: Responded with an Engine, Chief and Investigator to assist La Grange with a fire in a commercial business at 111 Kemman Ave.

06/20 (SAT) 8:32 AM: Responded to a report of smoke with smoke detectors sounding at 14 E. Harding. Upon arrival, a plastic coffee pot was found to have burned which was placed on a stovetop.

06/25 (THUR) 2:42 PM: Responded with an Engine to assist Brookfield with a significant house fire at 3308 Sunnyside Ave.

06/25 (THUR) 4:02 PM: Responded to the BP at 1045 N. La Grange Rd. for a vehicle with a damaged gas tank, leaking gasoline. Personnel assisted employs with containing spill, and then flushing area and sewers with water an emulsifying agent to reduce hazard.

EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES ACTIVITY REPORT – JUNE 2015

Ambulance Responses:

This month, EMT and Paramedic personnel responded to a total of 156 requests for emergency medical services treating a total of 165 patients. There were 113 calls located west of the IHB Railroad and 35 calls east of the IHB Railroad. Year to date, there has been a total of 868 requests for service providing care to 880 patients.

This compares to last year (June 2014) when there were 135 requests for service with a year to date total of 782 service requests.

Training and Continuing Education:

June is an off month for EMT and Paramedic Continuing Education. Regular monthly Continuing Education will resume in July of 2015.

Special Activities:

June 2nd - Firefighter/Paramedic Carbone attended the regular meeting of the EMS Region 8 Education Committee at Good Samaritan Hospital.
