


Optional Refuse and Yard Waste Cart Rental

Refuse and yard waste carts are available as an alternative to purchasing waste stickers. These carts are convenient, easy and cost effective. Customers are billed by Republic Services on a quarterly basis. Monthly cart rates represent a significant savings compared to purchasing the equivalent amount of stickers. A 65-gallon cart has the same capacity as two standard garbage cans; while a 95 gallon cart has the capacity of three standard garbage cans. The cost for a 65 gallon refuse cart is slightly less than the cost of using one waste sticker each week. **Refuse cart rental includes a recycle cart at no additional cost.** To subscribe, contact Republic Services by email at newtoter@republicservices.com or by phone at (708) 345-7050.

Refuse and Recycling Guide

The Village of La Grange Park has contracted with Allied Waste/Republic Services to provide refuse, recycling and yard waste collection. The guidelines in this brochure apply to all one and two family residences in La Grange Park.

The Village of La Grange Park program is flexible and is designed to encourage recycling. You may choose either to use waste stickers or to subscribe to one of two service plans with refuse carts. These options allow you to select the type of service that best meets your household's needs and budget.

Guidelines

There is no limit to the number of items that may be put out for collection. Items must be at the curb by 6:30 a.m. on the scheduled collection day, but no earlier than 6:00 p.m. on the day before collection. Empty garbage cans, carts and recycling containers must be removed from the curb by 7:00 p.m. on the day of collection.

Schedule

Republic Services collects on Thursday in La Grange Park. Refuse, recycling and yard waste are collected on the same day.

Collection Holidays

The following holidays are observed by Republic Services:

- ✓ New Year's Day
- ✓ Memorial Day
- ✓ Independence Day (July 4)
- ✓ Labor Day
- ✓ Thanksgiving Day
- ✓ Christmas Day

Other holidays do not affect the service schedule. During a holiday week, when one of these holidays falls on or before Thursday, collections are delayed until Friday.

Collection Guidelines

for the Village of

Recycling

Refuse

Bags, cans and bundles of material must not exceed 35 gallons in volume or 50 pounds in weight. All garbage must be set out for collection either in a Republic Services refuse cart or in a garbage can or garbage bag with a waste sticker attached. If a garbage can is used, please loop the sticker around one of the handles. Garbage cans must be no larger than 35 gallons and have two handles.

Yard Waste

Yard waste is collected from the first Thursday in April through the last scheduled collection day in November. In order to be collected, a waste sticker must be attached to each container or bundle. Yard waste may be placed in a biodegradable paper bag, an unlined 35-gallon can or a Republic Services yard waste cart. Bags, cans, or bundles may not weigh more than 50 pounds. Please MARK any yard waste containers on the outside as YARD WASTE or obtain a yard waste decal at Village Hall.

Brush and tree branches may not exceed 4 feet in length and 4 inches in diameter and must be bundled together with jute twine or uncoated string. Bundles must not exceed 2 feet in diameter, 4 feet in length or 50 pounds in weight.

Village Brush & Leaf Collection

The Village of La Grange Park collects unbundled branches monthly between May and October and loose leaves during an extended period in the fall. Detailed information on the curbside brush and branch and leaf collection program can be found in the *Rose Clippings* or on the Village website. Residents are reminded that brush pickup is strictly for residents who have performed tree and brush work on their own property. Contractors working for homeowners are not allowed to use this service.

Christmas Tree Collection

Free Christmas Tree collection is offered during the first two full weeks of January on the regular service day. Trees must be free of tinsel and ornaments and should not be placed in bags.

Large Household Items & Appliances

Bulk items and appliances that do not fit in a refuse container may be placed at the curb for pickup. Bulk items include chairs, tables and mattresses and other pieces of furniture that can be safely loaded. Large items include refrigerators, stoves and water heaters but do not include electronic waste. Rolls of carpeting and small amounts of construction debris may be set out for collection but must be securely tied in bundles not exceeding 2 feet in diameter, 4 feet in length or 50 pounds in weight. Two stickers must be attached to each bundle, large household item, or large appliance. Please call Republic Services at (708) 345-7050 with any questions.

Electronic Waste

Effective January 1, 2012, electronic items such as televisions, computers, monitors, printers and computer and cable peripherals are banned from landfill disposal. These items must be recycled. The Village sponsors a drop off event each October. (The schedule and other details can be found on the Village's website.) Household Hazardous Waste

Flammable, toxic, corrosive or reactive products cannot be included with regular refuse for disposal. Materials such as oil-based paint, pesticides, poisons, cleaning solvents, gasoline, motor oil and other automotive fluids are considered household hazardous waste. Special Pickup & Temporary Containers

If you have a large amount of refuse, Republic Services offers temporary containers or a special pickup. Arrangements must be made at least 24 hours in advance. Republic Services will quote a price for a temporary large container or special pickup based on the cubic yards to be removed. Call Republic Services for details at (708) 345-7050.

All accepted recyclables may be mixed together. Please rinse all items and flatten all boxes. RECYCLING BINS MAY BE PURCHASED AT THE VILLAGE HALL.

Accepted Items

- ✓ Newspaper
- ✓ Mixed paper: advertisements, direct mail, bills, office paper, stationery, and envelopes
- ✓ Magazines, catalogs and telephone directories
- ✓ Paper bags
- ✓ Cardboard pieces (3' x 3')
- ✓ Paperboard and boxboard (cereal boxes)
- ✓ Glass bottles and jars (all colors)
- ✓ Aluminum cans and clean foil
- ✓ Tin and steel cans, including empty aerosol cans and paint cans
- ✓ Plastic containers with the following numbers:
 - #1 PET bottles and containers
 - #2 HDPE bottles and containers
 - #3 PVC bottles
 - #4 LDPE bottles and containers
 - #5 PP plastic bottles and containers
 - #7 plastic narrow neck grocery containers
- ✓ Six and twelve pack rings
- ✓ Milk and juice cartons

Not Accepted Items

- ✗ Plastic bags and film
- ✗ Styrofoam containers and packing peanuts
- ✗ Plastic take-out containers, cups, plates, or utensils
- ✗ Needles or syringes
- ✗ Motor oil, anti-freeze, pool chemical containers
- ✗ Disposable diapers or rags
- ✗ Mirror or window glass, compact fluorescent or other light bulbs
- ✗ Electronic items
- ✗ Printer or toner cartridges
- ✗ Items such as pizza boxes, napkins and tissues soiled with grease or food residue
- ✗ Toys and ceramics
- ✗ Motor oil, insecticide, and hazardous chemical containers
- ✗ Clothes hangers

Waste Stickers



One sticker should be affixed to each garbage or yard waste bag or looped through the handle of each garbage and yard waste container. Two stickers must be attached to each bundle, large household item, or large appliance. **Containers larger than 35 gallons will not be emptied as they pose a safety risk to our workers.** This includes refuse carts not supplied by Republic Services.

Please be sure to specify La Grange Park waste stickers when purchasing from these locations. (Vendors are subject to change.)
