Re: Fire Department Activities – AUGUST 2015

As requested for insertion into the Village Board meeting agenda packet, the following is a brief summary of Fire Department activity highlights for the month of August. As usual, a more comprehensive monthly report is kept within the department for your review.

EMS Responses for this month – 148. There have been 1165 YTD compared to 1027 YTD in 2014. Fire/Rescue Incidents this month - 60. There have been 337 YTD compared to 354 YTD in 2014.

On Tuesday evening, August 4th, personnel participated in the National Night Out, by displaying Fire Department vehicles and having Sparky greet those in attendance.

Early in the month, EMS were called to a home in the Village for a male in cardiac arrest. CPR was initially performed by family members, and following aggressive Advanced Life Support treatment by EMS personnel, the patients pulse and breathing were restored, prior to arriving at the hospital.

During the month, personnel began using a home in the 500 block of N. Catherine Ave., which was scheduled for demolition, to conduct training.

08/02 (SUN) 12:44 PM: Responded for a garage fire at 640 N. Brainard Ave. It was quickly extinguished with a single hose line.

08/02 (SUN) 3:55 PM: Responded for a large gas leak in the 1200 block of Cleveland Ave. Firefighters stood by for over two hours while NICOR worked to secure the leak.

08/10 (MON) 12:33 PM: Responded for a box of paint on fire in the basement of a home at 531 N. Stone Ave. A contractor working in the home was able to extinguish most of the fire prior to our arrival with a handheld fire extinguisher.

08/18 (TUE) 8:38 PM: Responded for smoke in the basement of the home at 1215 Newberry caused by electrical wires melting in the basement. There was also an overhead power line that had come down behind the home with most likely contributed to the event.

08/31 (MON) 10:02 AM: Responded with a Plans Chief to assist the Pleasantview Fire District with a MABAS Dive response for a person who jumped off the La Grange Rd. bridge into the Des Plaines River.

08/31 (MON) 7:25 PM: Responded to and extinguished a truck fire on La Grange Rd. at Oak Ave.



EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES ACTIVITY REPORT – AUGUST 2015

Ambulance Responses:

This month, EMT and Paramedic personnel responded to a total of 148 requests for emergency medical services treating a total of 154 patients. There were 121 calls located west of the IHB Railroad and 20 calls east of the IHB Railroad. Year to date, there has been a total of 1165 requests for service providing care to 1186 patients.

This compares to last year (August 2014) when there were 124 requests for service with a year to date total of 1027 service requests.

Training and Continuing Education:

EMT Continuing Education was conducted on Tuesday, August 11th in the Community Room at Fire Station #1. Paramedic Continuing Education was conducted on Monday, August 17th, Wednesday, August 19th, and Friday, August 21st at the LaGrange Fire Department.

Probationary Firefighter Steve Selimos continues EMT-B training through the Loyola EMS System. Probationary Firefighters Chorley, Dahl, Hughes, Johnson, and Joyce began their EMT-B training through Triton College in River Grove.





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Garage Fire Extinguished in La Grange Park

La Grange Park, Illinois – The La Grange Park Fire Department was called to 640 N. Brainard Ave. yesterday, 08-02-15, for a garage fire. Fire companies were initially dispatched at 12:44 pm, and upon arrival at 12:49 pm, found fire and smoke coming from the garage. The fire was first discovered by neighbors, who notified the garage owners, who were inside their home at the time of the fire.

Fire companies attacked the fire with a single hose line, and the fire was controlled in approximately ten minutes. Firefighting efforts were helped by the fact that there were no contents in the garage. The owners were planning on having the garage demolished later this week, in order to build a new one. Firefighters remained on the scene for 40 minutes extinguishing hot spots, cleaning up debris, and picking up equipment.

The cause of the fire is under investigation, but it appears to have originated in an area inside of the garage, where a fire pit was being stored next to a wall of the garage. The fire pit was utilized the previous evening, and still contained ashes. There were no injuries, and damage is currently estimated at approximately \$5,000.00.

The La Grange Park Fire Department was assisted on the scene by the La Grange Fire Department. The Lyons, Riverside, and Westchester Fire Departments staffed La Grange Park stations while La Grange Park Firefighters were handling the fire.
