Re: Fire Department Activities – JANUARY 2016

As requested for insertion into the Village Board meeting agenda packet, the following is a brief summary of Fire Department activity highlights for the month of January. As usual, a more comprehensive monthly report is kept within the department for your review.

EMS Responses for this month - 138. There were 155 in January of 2015.
Fire/Rescue Incidents this month - 39. There were 47 in January of 2015.

A final fire alarm test and occupancy inspection were conducted for the new Brannick Clinic of Natural Medicine located at 1013 E. 31st St.

Following many years of service Firefighter/Paramedic Sue Breen resigned from her full-time position with PSSI during the month to take on a new job. She will remain as a paid-on-call Firefighter/Paramedic with the Village and we wish her well and thank her for her service.

A new passenger door was installed on the Village Hall building at the rear of Fire Station 1, which will be painted at a later date. The previous door was not securing properly and in need of replacement.

Two applications for the 2015 FEMA Assistance to Firefighters Grant program were submitted this month.

During the month, personnel attended training at the Lehigh-Hanson Quarry in McCook, to familiarize area emergency services personnel with the site and some new operations taking place there.

On January 11th at 5:02 pm, firefighters responded to a report of a dryer on fire in a home in the 1500 block of Beach. Upon arrival, firefighters found smoke coming from the dryer due to an overheated motor.

On January 16th at 2:29 am, firefighters responded to an activated fire alarm at an apartment building in the 1500 block of east 31st St. Upon arrival firefighters discovered a carbon monoxide alarm sounding, with high levels of CO throughout the building. The building was evacuated and firefighters ventilated the structure. Upon further investigation the boiler was discovered as the source of the CO and it had to be shut down until it could be repaired.

On January 19th at 2:49 pm, we responded with an Engine and Chief to assist the Brookfield FD with a downed power line which was burning on the rear patio of a home located in the 9500 block of Garfield.

EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES ACTIVITY REPORT – JANUARY 2016

Ambulance Responses:

This month, EMT and Paramedic personnel responded to a total of 138 requests for emergency medical services treating a total of 139 patients. There were 106 calls located west of the IHB Railroad and 22 calls east of the IHB Railroad.

This compares to last year (January 2015) when there were 155 requests for service.

Training and Continuing Education:

EMT Continuing Education conducted by the Loyola EMS System through our Associate Hospital – LaGrange Memorial, was conducted on Tuesday, January 12th in the Community Room at Fire Station #1. Paramedic Continuing Education was conducted on Monday, January 11th, Wednesday, January 13th, and Friday, January 15th at the LaGrange Fire Department.

Probationary Firefighter Stelmos is currently attending EMT-B training at Triton College in River Grove.






