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# Village Board Meeting Fire Department Activity Memo

**Re:** Fire Department Activities – JULY 2015

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As requested for insertion into the Village Board meeting agenda packet, the following is a brief summary of Fire Department activity highlights for the month of July. As usual, a more comprehensive monthly report is kept within the department for your review.

EMS Responses for this month - 149. There have been 1017 YTD compared to 903 YTD in 2014.  
Fire/Rescue Incidents this month - 41. There have been 277 YTD compared to 321 YTD in 2014.

All non-transport vehicles (such as fire apparatus) which contain Basic Life Support EMS equipment were inspected by the Loyola EMS system and Illinois Department of Public Health. They subsequently passed this annual inspection and were re-licensed.

Personnel participated in 4<sup>th</sup> of July parades in Riverside, Brookfield and Lyons. Also in the early evening of the 4<sup>th</sup>, we responded to assist Brookfield with an attic fire in a home on the 3200 block of Oak. Overnight on the 4<sup>th</sup>, we also responded to a garbage can on fire next to a garage in the 1200 block of Ostrander, which was most likely caused by firework debris.

Fire Prevention staff assisted with set-up inspections at the St. Louise De Marillac SummerFest. There was one emergency response to the fest for person suffering from a heat related injury.

Fire Prevention personnel assisted Loyola Medical Center employees with conducting a fire evacuation drill. EMS personnel also provided a CPR and AED class for a dental office in the Village.

07/02 (THUR) 2:46 PM: Responded for a vehicle fire at 515 N. La Grange Rd. Extinguished engine compartment fire with a portable fire extinguisher.

07/04 (SAT) 5:29 PM: Responded with a Chief, Engine and Investigator to assist Brookfield with an attic fire in a house at 3229 Oak Ave.

07/05 (SUN) 12:38 AM: Responded for a fire in a garbage can next to the garage at 1200 Ostrander Ave. Assisted resident with extinguishing fire, which was most likely caused by discarded fireworks.

07/09 (THUR) 5:40 PM: Responded to a power line down next to the Jewel-Osco at 507 E. Woodlawn. Secured area until ComEd arrived and deemed condition safe.

07/09 (THUR) 11:48 PM: Responded to Bethlehem Woods to assist with resetting elevators, and assisting residents back to upper floors, following a power outage and generator failure earlier in the evening.

07/10 (FRI) 3:11 AM: Responded with an Engine to assist Westchester with a house fire. Our Engine staged in Westchester's Fire Station to stand-by for other incidents in their Village while they tended to the fire.

## EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES ACTIVITY REPORT – JULY 2015

### Ambulance Responses:

This month, EMT and Paramedic personnel responded to a total of 149 requests for emergency medical services treating a total of 152 patients. There were 113 calls located west of the IHB Railroad and 24 calls east of the IHB Railroad. Year to date, there has been a total of 1017 requests for service providing care to 1032 patients.

This compares to last year (July 2014) when there were 134 requests for service with a year to date total of 903 service requests.

### Training and Continuing Education:

EMT Continuing Education was conducted on Tuesday, July 14<sup>th</sup> in the Community Room at Fire Station #1. Paramedic Continuing Education was conducted on Monday, July 13<sup>th</sup>, Wednesday, July 15<sup>th</sup>, and Friday, July 17<sup>th</sup> at the LaGrange Fire Department.

Probationary Firefighter Steve Selimos began EMT-B training through the Loyola EMS System. Probationary Firefighters Chorley, Dahl, Hughes, Johnson, and Joyce are scheduled to begin their EMT-B training in August through Triton College in River Grove.

### Special Activities:

July 6<sup>th</sup> - Firefighter/Paramedic Carbone attended the regular meeting of the EMS Region 8 Education Committee at Good Samaritan Hospital.

In July, the Asthma medication "Albuterol" was added to the medical equipment and supplies being carried on all our BLS non-transport vehicles. This medication, delivered in conjunction with oxygen, was recently approved by the Loyola EMS System for use by both EMT-Bs and Paramedics. Since our Paramedic Ambulances already carried this medication, all the EMT-Bs were provided in service training on the use of this item.

In July, our Department CPR and AED Instructors conducted BLS for Healthcare Provider training classes for the staff at Dr. Fieldhouse's Dental Practice. There were 12 staff members who received this CPR and AED certification.

In July, all of our BLS non-transport vehicles were inspected for compliance with the Illinois Department of Public Health and the Loyola EMS System. All of these vehicles were re-licensed. This is an annual inspection process to make sure that our medical equipment and supplies are up to industry standards. Our Paramedic Ambulances are scheduled for their compliance inspections in September.






