PURPOSE

This agenda item seeks Board approval to award the lowest bid to A Lamp Concrete Contractors, Inc. for completion of water main improvements along 31st Street from Meadowcrest to Barnsdale.

GENERAL BACKGROUND

The Village Engineer developed project plans and specifications, a Notice to Bidders requesting job bids was published in the April 16, 2020 edition of the Suburban Life newspaper. A bid opening was held on April 30, 2020 (via teleconference) and results are the following:

Bids were received for the above referenced project on April 30, 2020. We offer the following comments and recommendations on the bid results.

The plans and specifications for the project were solicited from nineteen (19) contractors, and the Village received bids from eight (8) qualified companies. A summary of the bids received is as follows:

A Lamp Concrete Contractors, Inc.	\$1,214,432.00

Suburban General Construction, Inc.	\$1,418,384.00

The bids were checked and found to be in order with the exception of Archon Construction. They had two line item subtotals that were not correct. The lowest bidder, A Lamp Concrete Contractors, is a qualified local Chicago area contractor who has satisfactorily completed municipal projects throughout the Chicago area and is certified by IDOT. They provide both underground and concrete paving capabilities. Therefore, we recommend that the Village accept the bid proposal submitted by A Lamp Concrete Contractors, Inc. in the amount of \$1,214,432.00. I am also returning the original proposals submitted by the contractors.

Re: Sidewalk, and Curb/Gutter Replacement Contract – One Year Extension

PURPOSE

To approve a one-year extension with Globe Construction to preform concrete restoration services through Fiscal Year 2020/21.

GENERAL BACKGROUND

Each year the Village budgets funding for concrete work related to the Annual Sidewalk Replacement Program and concrete restoration related to utility repairs. In the proposed Fiscal Year 2020/21 budget, \$24,500 is budgeted in the Motor Fuel Tax Fund. Under this program, the Village replaces sidewalks that are determined to be a potential trip hazard at no cost to the residents. An additional \$10,000 is budgeted in the Water Fund to replace curb/gutter removed due to water main repairs.

Also, this upcoming fiscal year, the Village will provide a pass-through pilot program for residential participation for sidewalk removal and replacement at our contract pricing. Staff anticipates that the pilot program will cost an additional \$10,000 (with revenue also budgeted at \$10,000).

- Annual Sidewalk Replacement Program
 - Motor Fuel Tax (04-40-3-342) \$24,500
- Restorations from Utility Repairs
 - Water Fund (03-44-3-308) \$10,000
- Sidewalk Replacement Participation
 - Cost Neutral (Revenue Source) \$10,000
- Total \$44,500

Public Works would encourage the Village Board to waive the competitive bid process and enter into an extension with Globe Construction. In 2016, Globe Construction was awarded a contract based on being the lowest reasonable bidder, and their firm agrees to hold their pricing from that time. Globe Construction continues to provide competitive pricing, and their work is honorable.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends approving a one-year contract extension with Globe Construction and “waive competitive bids” with a “not to exceed” amount of \$44,500 at the May 12, 2020, Work Session meeting.

Re: Vehicle and Dog License Due Dates

PURPOSE

Consider changing the due dates for vehicle and dog licenses from July 31st to October 31st.

BACKGROUND

Per Village Code, vehicle licenses are due July 31st and dog licenses are due June 30th with a grace period until August 15th. During the Village budget process in April, staff provided a number of recommendations in response to the COVID-19 pandemic. One recommendation was to postpone the due date for vehicle licenses to October 31st in order to provide some financial relief to residents and minimize the number of people at Village Hall. The Finance Committee and Village Board reviewed the due date change during the budget meetings and expressed support.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

While the due date change is recommended now due to COVID-19, it has been considered previously by staff because vehicle sticker sales currently coincide with summer building permits, resulting in longer wait times for customers at Village Hall. Dog tags are typically sold at the same time as vehicle stickers, therefore staff recommends the due dates for both vehicle stickers and dog licenses be changed to October 31st in the Village Code. Additionally, all ancillary dates, such as the dates for incrementing late fees and proration for new residents will be modified to fit with the new due date.

ACTION REQUESTED

If the Board concurs with changing the due dates, the following motion is proposed for the May 12th meeting. Staff will then prepare an ordinance with the necessary changes to the Village Code for approval by the Board in June.

Motion to direct staff to prepare an ordinance changing the due dates for vehicle licenses and dog licenses to October 31st.
