Re: Fire Department Activities – OCTOBER2023

As requested for insertion into the Village Board meeting agenda packet, the following is a brief summary of Fire Department activity highlights for the month of October. As usual, a more comprehensive monthly report is kept within the department for your review.

EMS Incidents this month - 176. There have been 1572 YTD compared to 1442 YTD in 2022.
Fire/Rescue Incidents this month - 42. There have been 461 YTD compared to 489 YTD in 2022.

In recognition of Fire Prevention Week during the month, personnel conducted and participated in several activities, including the following.

- Our annual Open House was conducted on October 7th. Staff did a great job on the event, most importantly, making sure attendees took away both new and reaffirmed fire safety messages.
- Personnel provided several fire safety presentations to students at most of our schools, including Barnsdale, Forest Rd, Brook-Park, and Ready Teddy Preschool. We also provided various safety materials for the students to take home.
- Personnel participated in the regional Silent Parade, which is a dedication to firefighters and civilians who have lost their lives in fires.

Personnel assisted with the also participated in the Haunted Trolley Trick or Treat event with our Station 2 Open House, and also attended the St. Michael's Trunk or Treat event.

Staff conducted annual hose testing on several weekends throughout the month.

Staff, with help from Madelyn, pushed hard on recruiting throughout the month. New banners and posters were displayed and distributed, and we held our first Informational Session, attended by 20 people.

Many meetings and inspections took place related to the Plymouth Place project, including firefighters assisting with flow testing of standpipes, making sure we can get adequate water for firefighting inside up levels of the buildings.

Several personnel participated in live fire training at the Romeoville Fire Academy, hosted by the MABAS Division 10 Training Officers Committee.

Incidents of Note:

- ***Thursday, 10/18, 8:00 pm*** – Responded to a dumpster on fire behind 411 E. 31st St. A tenant of the building deliberately set a couch on fire to reduce its' size, so it would fit in dumpster.
- ***Friday, 10/31 6:41 am*** – Responded to a vehicle crash between a Crossover/SUV and Semi-truck at Harding and La Grange. The SUV rolled over off the roadway, took down a traffic signal, and landed on its' side in front of The Grove monument sign.

EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES ACTIVITY REPORT – OCTOBER 2023

Ambulance Responses:

This month EMT and Paramedic personnel responded to a total of 176 requests for emergency medical services treating a total of 170 patients. There were 138 calls located west of the IHB Railroad and 25 calls east of the IHB Railroad. We gave mutual 13 times and received it 25 times. Year to date there has been a total of 1,572 requests for emergency medical services caring for a total of 1,601 patients.

This compares to last year (October 2022) when there were 150 requests for a year to date total of 1,442 requests.

Training and Continuing Education:

October monthly continuing education was conducted in the week of 10/9/2023. The topic was septic emergencies.

PSI Paramedic Ivan Garcia has been attending the Romeoville Fire Academy and is set to graduate later this year.

Special Activities:



Approximately 20% of the basic pre-plan components for our commercial occupancies have been completed.


