As requested for insertion into the Village Board meeting agenda packet, the following is a brief summary of Fire Department activity highlights for the month of April. As usual, a more comprehensive monthly report is kept within the department for your review.

EMS Incidents this month - 151. There have been 615 YTD compared to 608 YTD in 2023.  
Fire/Rescue Incidents this month - 50. There have been 187 YTD compared to 172 YTD in 2023.

The office areas of Fire Station 2 were painted, and new carpet was installed. Thanks to our personnel who helped coordinate this and move furniture and equipment, and Paramedic/Firefighter Jim Tolf, who did the painting.

Several of our personnel attended live training at the Romeoville Fire Academy which was hosted by the Division 10 Training Officers. Two of our personnel assisted with instruction.

Candidates trained on vehicle extrication as part of their Fire Academy. Squad 1226 was taken to the drill site in Carol Stream so they could utilize and become familiar with our rescue tools.

Staff worked with Madelyn on a final design for the next vehicle sticker, which will honor the Fire Department's 125<sup>th</sup> Anniversary, taking place next year, in February of 2025.

Personnel participated in MABAS Division 10 Rapid Intervention Team training, which took place at the former Countryside Village Hall building.

Our new grant funded multi-band mobile radios were installed in our fire vehicles.

Several Fire Department personnel participated in the Ace Hardware 100<sup>th</sup> Anniversary event.

Chief Maggos attended FDIC International late last week in Indianapolis, which includes great educational sessions, product demonstrations networking. There were over 36,500 attendees from 67 different countries.

### **Incidents of Interest**

- *On Tuesday April 9 at 8:44 am, personnel responded to a mini-van fire in the main parking lot at Barnsdale School. It was extinguished fairly quickly but some minor damage occurred to four vehicles parked adjacent to the van due to the radiant heat.*
- *On Thursday April 11 at 1:04 pm, personnel responded to a pedestrian struck by a car who was crossing Homestead at La Grange Rd.*
- *On Sunday April 21 at 10:21 am, personnel responded to oil that spilled in the roadway in the 200 block of East 31<sup>st</sup>, and created a hazard. FD personnel spread oil-absorbent and requested PW, who responded with a load of sand. IDOT then came out and cleaned the road.*

## EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES ACTIVITY REPORT – APRIL 2024

### Ambulance Responses:

This month, EMT and Paramedic personnel responded to a total of 151 requests for emergency medical services treating a total of 148 patients. There were 116 calls located west of the IHB Railroad and 22 calls east of the IHB Railroad. We gave mutual 13 times and received it 17 times. Year to date there has been a total of 615 requests for emergency medical services caring for a total of 609 patients.

This compares to last year (April 2023) when there were 144 requests for service treating 148 patients.

### Training and Continuing Education:

Paramedic/EMT-B Monthly Continuing Education was conducted on April 8<sup>th</sup>, 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> for paramedics and EMT-Bs. The topic was altered mental status emergencies.

### Special Activities:

EMS Week is May 19 – 25. This is a national campaign that recognizes emergency medical services professionals. The theme of this year's EMS week is "Honoring our past, forging our future" and marks the 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of this campaign. There will be FREE BBQ available at Hinsdale and LaGrange on the following days: Wednesday, May 22<sup>nd</sup> at the LaGrange Hospital Ambulance ER bay 11am until 2pm and on Thursday, May 23<sup>rd</sup> in the Hinsdale Ambulance ER bay 11am until 2pm. There will be free BBQ and raffle prizes. All are welcomed and encouraged to attend.

The Fire Department will be providing EMS standby coverage for the Annual Run for the Roses scheduled for the morning of Sunday, May 19 from approximately 7am until noon.

PSI Contract Paramedic and Firefighter Ivan Garcia has accepted a fulltime position with the Franklin Park Fire Department. His last shift day with the La Grange Park Fire Department will be Saturday, May 4<sup>th</sup>. We wish him well and thank him for his time here.

**825 E 26<sup>th</sup> St:** Sometime during the week of 4/15/24 a truck severely damaged the pump house, and test head. On 4/22/24 the LGPK police notified the fire department. On 4/22/24 Capt. Fagan made contact with the tenant in person and the owner via email. Although the fire pump and supply pipe appeared to be undamaged, Capt. Recommended that the pump and piping be assessed by the pump maintenance company to determine if it will function properly in lieu of repairs.
