Re: Fire Department Activities – FEBRUARY 2025

As requested for insertion into the Village Board meeting agenda packet, the following is a brief summary of Fire Department activity highlights for the month of February. As usual, a more comprehensive monthly report is kept within the department for your review.

EMS Incidents this month - 168. There have been 381 YTD compared to 322 YTD in 2024.
Fire/Rescue Incidents this month - 36. There have been 101 YTD compared to 101 YTD in 2024.

EMS staff provided a CPR class for Montessori Children's Place.

Staff participated in the Heroes vs. Heroes game against the Mighty Patriots, the Park Junior High Special Olympics team.

Personnel participated in in Rescue Task Force Training at La Grange Hospital.

Personnel completed a remodeling of our Fire Station 1 Dayroom and Kitchenette. Special thanks to PM/FF's Jim Tolf and Paul Eggerding, who did most of the cabinet work and painting.

The Fire Department Association sponsored our Annual Appreciation Dinner.

A retirement gathering was held for Firefighter/EMT-B Mike Hughes

Ambulance 1214 was hit by a vehicle on 31st Street while crossing the railroad tracks. The driver of the other vehicle hit the accelerator instead of the brake, and tried to go between the ambulance and vehicle next to it, striking the ambulance and the other car

All radios were reprogrammed during the month to accommodate Brookfield and other communities changing to a different radio system.

The Duty Officer and Chief assisted Plymouth Place with an IDPH required Night Evacuation Drill.

Incidents of Interest

On Saturday February 1st at 11:00 am, we responded to a report of the smell of something burning in a home in the 500 block of Newberry. Personnel investigated and identified a problem with an electric fireplace in the basement.

On Wednesday February 5th at 1:15 am, we responded with an Engine and Chief to assist Brookfield with a garage fire. The fire spread to a boat stored in an adjacent yard.

On Wednesday February 5th at 1:29 pm, we responded to the 700 block of Barnsdale for a small fire in the front yard that appeared to be caused by extension cords.



EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES ACTIVITY REPORT – FEBRUARY 2025

Ambulance Responses:

This month, EMT and Paramedic personnel responded to a total of 168 requests for emergency medical services treating a total of 163 patients. There were 135 calls located west of the IHB Railroad and 17 calls east of the IHB Railroad. We gave mutual 16 times and received it 14 times. Year to date there has been a total of 381 requests for emergency medical services caring for a total of 376 patients.

This compares to last year (February 2024) when there were 155 requests for service treating 156 patients and year to date totals February 2024; 322 requests/319 patients.

Training and Continuing Education:

PSI Contract paramedic Jake Weiner completed his Basic Operations Fire Certification from the Romeoville Fire Academy and is set to graduate on March 7, 2025.

FF/EMT-Bs Lou DeJesus and Mike Murray successfully renewed their EMT-B license with the Illinois Department of Public Health (IDPH).


