Re: Fire Department Activities – APRIL 2025

As requested for insertion into the Village Board meeting agenda packet, the following is a brief summary of Fire Department activity highlights for the month of April. As usual, a more comprehensive monthly report is kept within the department for your review.

EMS Incidents this month - 164. There have been 723 YTD compared to 615 YTD in 2024.
Fire/Rescue Incidents this month - 49. There have been 215 YTD compared to 187 YTD in 2024.

Haz-Mat personnel attended monthly Team training held at Argonne.

After a slight delay, a \$59,457.17 payment was approved by FEMA for the Assistance to Firefighters Grant that we had previously obtained for new mobile radios.

Both fire stations were lit up red as part of the Light the Night for Fallen Firefighters program.

Minor body work was completed on Ambulance 1214 from a previous crash, where a driver drove into the ambulance on 31st. Various repairs were also made to Squad 1226 during the month.

Chief 1201 attended portions of the Fire Department Instructors Conference in Indianapolis. The overall event was attended by over 37,000 people from 50 countries.

Training staff began assessing the home at 1024 Newberry for potential use for live fire training.

EMS personnel continue to respond to a substantial number of lift assists. Staff has been further discussing appropriate response procedures and potential cost recovery for high-frequency use.

Our IT rack at Fire Station 2 was relocated to a more secure area, and to one less prone to accidental damage. We were able to do a portion of the work in-house, as one of our firefighters, who is also an electrician, assisted with installing the necessary power.

The Foreign Fire Insurance Board held a meeting during the month to hold elections.

Incidents of Interest

On Monday April 14th at 3:07 pm, Engine 1221 and Chief 1201 responded to assist Brookfield with a house fire in the 3500 block of Madison. 1201 was assigned the Interior, and the 1221 crew assisted with overhaul and utility control. Also, Captain Fagan assisted with the Fire Investigation.

EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES ACTIVITY REPORT – April 2025

Ambulance Responses:

This month, EMT and Paramedic personnel responded to a total of 164 requests for emergency medical services treating a total of 164 patients. There were 130 calls located west of the IHB Railroad and 19 calls east of the IHB Railroad. We gave mutual 15 times and received it 16 times. Year to date there has been a total of 723 requests for emergency medical services caring for a total of 715 patients.

This compares to last year (April 2024) when there were 151 requests for service treating 148 patients and year to date totals were 615 requests for service treating 609 patients.

Training and Continuing Education:

All Paramedics and EMT's attended Loyola Ce on 4/8/2025 at 19:00 at Fire Station 1 and 4/14, 4/16, 4/18/2025 at Lagrange Fire Department.

Special Activities:

EMS Week is May 18 – 24. This is a national campaign that recognizes emergency medical services professionals. There will be a BBQ on Wednesday, May 21st at the LaGrange Hospital Ambulance ER bay 11am until 2pm and Loyola Hospital ambulance entrance parking lot from 11am until 1:30pm. On Thursday, May 22nd in the Hinsdale Ambulance ER bay from 11am until 2pm. All are welcomed and encouraged to attend.

The Fire Department will be providing EMS standby coverage for the Annual Run for the Roses scheduled for the morning of Sunday, May 18 from approximately 7am until noon.
